

In 2022, we gave £674,226 to charities in the Channel Islands.

Lloyds Bank Foundation for the Channel Islands supports charities helping to improve the lives of people who are disadvantaged, disabled or excluded.

Last year we were able to give a cost-of-living uplift payment to our charity partners, alongside our grant giving, distributing a further £61,375.

As well as funding charities, the Foundation provides developmental support, including mentoring, to help charities improve their resilience and sustainability.

Our strategy is determined by our Board of Trustees, who meet three times each year to discuss and agree grant applications.
